Communication

Communication between home and preschool is essential in the smooth running of the preschool.

Please inform us of any changes such as mobile phone numbers, addresses etc to we can keep our records up to date and can always get hold of you if we need to. Please also share any information that may affect your child's well-being such a change with family circumstances or family bereavement with the manager or your child's key person, so we can offer tailored support to your child if required. All information shared will be in confidence and only discussed with staff on a need to know basis.

Also...

- Your child's Learning Journeys are kept in the rooms, you are welcome to look at them anytime and add photos and information from home.
- o In each room is a 'family board' with photos of the children and their families. It would be great if all families could bring in or email 1 or 2 photos to put on the board. If emailing photos is easier we are happy to print them off. This helps with settling in and is always a good talking point for the children!
- Keep up to date with news and reminders by checking the notice boards, emails and joining our private Facebook group just search Busy Bees Preschool, Salisbury and look for our logo. Also check your child's drawer every session for letters & pictures.
- We respectfully ask that parents do not request staff as friends on social media unless you know the staff members previously. Our expectations is for staff to have a professional relationship with parents at all times.
- Please remember Busy Bees has an 'open door' policy so you are welcome to phone or pop in anytime for a chat or if you have any concerns.
- o **Preschool fees will be increasing from January 2020**; 2 year olds to £5.25, 3 & 4 year olds will increase to £4.30. Fees have not risen for over 3 years however the increase is necessary due to the ongoing increase in Preschool running costs
